He married Mary Patterson, daughter of James Patterson and Mary (nee Unknown), in 1843 in Armagh, Northern Ireland<sup>4</sup>. She was born on 20 Sep 1823 in Armagh, Northern Ireland<sup>4-5</sup>. She died on 24 Sep 1900 in Rose, Waushara, Wisconsin, USA<sup>5</sup>.

Notes for Mary Patterson:

The only information about this family and their trip to the USA comes from Mary Patterson Stevenson's obituary. She was Joseph's mother. According to that obituary, Mary and her husband George were married in 1843 in County Armagh. They lived in County Down from 1843 to 1845. Then they moved to Belfast in Counties Atrim and Down. They lived in Belfast from 1845 to 1867. They left Belfast for Wisconsin in 1867. The potato famine was from 1845 to 1852, so that was not what pushed them to the US. I have a hunch it was opportunities for land in the US. In Ireland, all of the land was owned and most had to rent if they wanted to farm. Our Stevenson family was not among the land-owning class.

Thanks to cousins sharing information with me, we know that this family is Scots Irish. What does that mean? It means that they were a Protestant Christian family who did not worship at the Protestant Church recognized by the country they were living in. They were pushed from country to country to avoid persecution from the state church of Scotland to Northern Ireland. I suspect that this family was originally pushed from England to Scotland because Stevenson is an English surname, not a traditional Scottish surname.

What did Protestants like our ancestors face? Discrimination. To register births/baptisms, marriages, and deaths/burials people had to use the church sanctioned by the country they lived in. This church was the official record keeper for that country. They could marry in their church and may have to marry again in the state church. They may have to pay the minister more because they were not church members. Merchants in the area they lived in could choose not to do business with them or charge them more. They could have received verbal harassment while in town or their children may have received it at school. Given the founding fathers of the United States of America were Protestants in the same situation, do you see why they wanted separation of church and state?

My first attempt to research Irish records to double check birth dates, etc. yielded no information about our family. I will try again in the future.
