Our Evans family came from Wales. It appears that James and Lydia came to the U.S. with their families and were married, probably, in New York. According to Lydia, she came to the U.S. when she was 13. She and James did not have a child until she was 22 years old. I bet they married a year or so before their first child was born.

The first three children were born in the state of New York. I do not know where in New York. By 1850 the family was living in Ottawa, Waukesha County, Wisconsin. By 1870 they moved to Springwater, Waushara County, Wisconsin. I do not know where they were for the 1860 census. I cannot find them in Ottawa or Springwater. Thanks to the 1850 census taker, everyone in the family was listed by their initials. I think A. might be Ann. I have no idea who E. E., the eldest child, is. I only know he is male. The death dates listed as 1933 are really listed, "before 1933." All of Evan's living brothers and sisters are listed in his obituary. Those that were not listed I recorded as died before 1933.

For now I am at a standstill for this family. I need to get back to Wisconsin to look for obituaries from this family in the newspaper. Hopefully this will tell me where in New York the family was. Maybe it will also tell me more about James and Lydia's childhood and families in the U.S. and when James came to the U.S..
